

Your Role

Lead in developing and building a strong community of arts societies. Working with the Activities and Engagement Officer, oversee all arts societies in the Union and develop opportunities for students to pursue a rich range of artistic interests at UCL.

Issues You May Work On

As a Student Officer, you will work closely with students and Sabbatical Officers. Issues may vary depending on student concern. However, previous Officers have worked on issues such as:

- Making sure that Arts societies are as inclusive and engaging as possible.
- Working with the Activities and Engagement Officer to promote an inter-societal community within the Arts Societies, and the clubs and societies community as a whole.
- Ensure that the interests of Arts societies members are represented within relevant decision-making processes in the Union.
