Your Role

Hall Reps provide an important feedback mechanism for UCL Accommodation, ensuring that the student voice is built into projects and developments. Hall Reps champion the student experience in halls and help to ensure UCL provides positive living and learning environments for its students. You will advocate for good standards of living, affordability, and accessibility, as well as helping to build the hall community by promoting and attending community-building activities.

Your Responsibility

- Represent your fellow UCL Accommodation residents
- Provide a link between students in your halls, the Union and the University
- Be an active member of the Welfare and Community Zone

Your Eligibility

Current residents of the specific hall or hall groupings. Students here for 1 term only are uneligible to stand. Job shares are not permitted. Once you have moved out of Halls, you are no longer eligible to be a Hall Rep.

Time Required For Role

Being a Hall Rep is a part-time position and you will receive a remuneration for your contributions upon successful completion of:

- A termly hall report
- Attendance at Welfare and Community Zone
- Attendance at the termly Hall Rep Forum
